


NOTICE TO MARINERS No 41 (T) of 2024

IFA2 Route Maintenance operations – Stage 3

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN jointly by the King's Harbour Master Portsmouth and the Harbour Master ABP Southampton that as part of the IFA2 Interconnector Project, Survey and maintenance works are planned to take place in the Eastern Solent by Prysmian Powerlink on behalf of the National Grid from the 11th February 2024 until further notice (Stage 3). Information about following works stages will be advertised by further LNTMs.

The works area is approximately 1.5 NM SSW of Gilkicker Point (as indicated on the below chartlet) by the Red Dot.



Stage 3 works will be undertaken by the Multicat Work Vessel "**ROXANE Z**" (IMO 9751456; MMSI 228056800; Call Sign FIRJ).



ROXANE Z will commence cable burial operations in the area. Mariners are requested to pass at a safe speed observing **a 200m guard Zone** around the works vessels. The Guard Zone will be marked by the following guard vessels:

- Until 0600 22/02/2024: "CC6"
- From 0600 22/02 to 0600 23/02: "BOSSY BOOTS"
- From 0600 23/02 to 0600 26/02: "CC6"
- From 0600 26/02 until further notice: "LAPWING"
