(Update and Re-Issue of Notice to Mariners No 09 of 2014)

Speed of Vessels when Taking Tugs

- 1 **MARINERS ARE REMINDED THAT** when making tugs fast consideration is to be given to the vessel's speed, such that it is not excessive for the tug.
- 2 The attention of Masters and Pilots is drawn to Marine Guidance Note (MGN) 199(M) 'Dangers of Interaction', para: 5, which deals with the dangers of this manoeuvre and they are advised to ensure that this manoeuvre is carried out at a speed acceptable to the tug, as recommended in the MGN.
