

NOTICE TO MARINERS

No 11 of 2016

(Update and Re-Issue of Notice to Mariners No 11 of 2014)

Port of Southampton - Southampton Water **Controlled Anchorage Area**

- 1 **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that vessels are not permitted to anchor in the Controlled Anchorage Area between Hamble Point Buoy and Coronation Buoy (for vessels of less than 91.4m (300 feet) in length), as indicated on Admiralty Chart 2038 Southampton Water and Approaches, without the permission of the Harbour Master, Southampton.
- 2 Inbound vessels are required to call Call Sign 'Southampton VTS' on VHF Ch 12 for permission to anchor in the above Controlled Anchorage Area before entering The Precautionary Area (Thorn Channel) or The North Channel.
- 3 Vessels secured alongside intending to anchor or moor in the Controlled Anchorage Area shall obtain permission to do so before getting underway.
