Port of Southampton - Firework Displays

Eastern Docks January 2017

Notice is hereby given that on the below listed dates firework displays will take place in the vicinity of the Eastern Docks, Port of Southampton, to mark the departure of Arcadia, Oriana, Queen Victoria, Queen Elizabeth, Aurora and Queen Mary 2.

The firework displays will take place at approximately 1645 GMT and be launched from a barge which will be positioned south east of Dock Head and outside the main channel in the vicinity of the Moorhead Buoy. The display will last for approximately 15 minutes and will be fired as the vessels pass the barge.

Owners of small craft who intend to view the display are advised that they should remain at least 300 metres clear from the barge at all times.

All mariners are advised that navigation in the main channel, to the north west of the Hound / Lains Lake Buoys will be subject to restriction from 15 minutes before until 15 minutes after the displays.

Mariners should consult Southampton VTS to confirm the display time and timings for movements in the normal manner.

This notice will be self-cancelling on conclusion of the display, on Sunday 11th January 2017.
