Pilot Boarding Points – Eastern Solent

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with the publication of Admiralty charts BA2037 and BA2045, the following changes have been made to the pilot boarding points for the Port of Southampton:

- 'A' - Pilot boarding station, located at 50°36.07'N 0°57.54'W 4 miles South of Nab Tower.
- 'B' – Pilot boarding station located at 50°39.39'N 0°55.11'W within the Nab East Pilot Boarding Area.
- 'C' – Pilot boarding station located at 50°39.49'N 0°58.42'W within the Nab West Pilot Boarding Area.
- 'D' – Pilot boarding station located at 50°41.80'N 0°57.90'W – new Pilot boarding point.
- 'E' – Pilot boarding station located at 50°43.37'N 1°01.77'W within the St. Helens Pilot boarding area.
- 'F' – Pilot boarding station located at 50°45.83'N 1°09.09'W, formally North Sturbridge Pilot boarding station.

Vessels will be directed to the appropriate boarding point by Southampton VTS.

This notice will be self-cancelling on 31st December 2018 as sufficiently promulgated.
