

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Maintenance Dredging Shamrock Quay and Hythe Marina Approach November 2019 to January 2020

Notice is hereby given that maintenance dredging works will take place in Shamrock Quay and Hythe Marina Village Approach Channel.

The works will commence on or about Monday 25th November 2019 in Shamrock Quay until approximately Friday 13th December 2019.

Hythe Marina Village Approach Channel works will commence on or about Monday 6th January 2020 and continue until approximately Friday 24th January 2020.

The backhoe dredging works will be conducted by the vessel 'DOREEN DORWARD', and the split hopper barges 'NAB' and 'NEEDLES' will carry the spoil to the Nab disposal ground.

All craft will display the lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and both dredger and hopper barges will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout.

Mariners are requested to reduce speed, as safe navigation permits, when passing the 'DOREEN DORWARD' when engaged in underwater activities.

This Notice will be self-cancelling on completion of the dredging operations.
