DPW Southampton – (Dubai Ports World) Container Terminal, TSHD Dredging Programme

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Trailer Suction hopper dredger 'WATERWAY' will be engaged in dredging Berths SCT1 - 3 and SCT5 at Dubai Ports World (Southampton) (DPW(S)) Container Terminal for a period of approximately 1 week, commencing on or after 23rd January 2021.



As dredging operations will be continuous throughout the period, mariners should expect to pass the TSHD at any time between the upper reaches of the River Test, Southampton Water and the Nab disposal area. The vessel will be under pilotage between the River Test and North Sturbridge or to The Nab.

The Dredger will display the lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (ColRegs) and mariners are requested to reduce speed, as safe navigation permits, when passing the vessel whilst engaged in dredging or loading activities.

All vessels involved will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout the operations, and mariners may also request movement information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.
