

## **NOTICE TO MARINERS**

**No 43(T) of 2017**

### **Port of Southampton – River Itchen – No 2 Beacon**

### **Damaged – Temporary Replacement**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that No 2 Beacon, a lit green pile with topmark, positioned downstream of Weston Jetty in the River Itchen (position 50° 53.292'N, 01° 23.377'W) has been damaged and is leaning in an upstream direction, submerged at high water, thus hazardous to river traffic. A temporary, lit yellow buoy has been deployed in the vicinity of the damaged beacon. It is intended that the damaged beacon will be removed and re-instated.

Vessels are requested to proceed with caution when navigation in the vicinity of the damaged beacon. Ahead of their passage, mariners may also request shipping information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.

This notice will be self-cancelling when No 2 Beacon has been replaced and the temporary buoy removed.
