TRAVELLING TO YOUR CRUISE TERMINAL ON EMBARKATION DAY

WESTERN DOCKS

MAYFLOWER CRUISE TERMINAL (BERTH 106)

By Foot

From Dock Gate 10 the walk is approximately 1 miles (20 minutes)
From Southampton Central Train Station the walk is approximately 1.5 mile (30 minutes)

By Train

The closest train station is *Southampton Central Station*. For easiest access to the cruise terminals, please exit via southern side of the railway station.

There is a taxi rank directly outside both the northern and southern side of the train station and can drop-off passengers directly outside of the cruise terminal.

Alternatively, the walk from Southampton Central Train Station to Mayflower Cruise Terminal is approximately 1.5 miles (30 minutes).

By Bus

Bus services for the Western Docks are limited. Mayflower Cruise Terminal does not have a direct bus stop in its vicinity.

By Coach (National Express)

The closest coach station is Southampton Coach Station on Harbour Parade which is serviced by National Express.

You can take a pre-booked taxi from this location to the cruise terminal. Travel time is approximately 5 minutes, via Dock Gate 10, depending on traffic. There is a taxi rank at the coach station, alternatively there is a rank at Southampton Central Station which is approximately 0.3 miles away (6 minute walk).

Alternatively, the walk from Southampton Coach Station to Mayflower Cruise Terminal is approximately 1.5 miles (30 minutes) via Dock Gate 10.

By Taxi

Private taxis can drop off directly outside of the cruise terminal. There is a taxi rank directly outside of each cruise terminal too.

By Car

For Mayflower Cruise Terminal, recommended access to the port is via Dock Gate 20. At the 1st roundabout, take the 1st exit down Western Avenue. Continue until you reach a 2nd roundabout and take the 2nd exit to continue down Western Avenue. You will proceed over a level crossing before reaching a 3rd roundabout. At the 3rd roundabout take the 2nd exit, heading straight over onto West Bay Road. Continue along this road until the obvious right-hand turn down Imperial Way. Head to the end of Imperial Way, turning left at the end, and the terminal will be directly on your right-hand side.

For entry via Dock Gate 10, at the 1st roundabout take the 2nd exit sticking to the right-hand lane (avoiding the 'Horizon Only') lane. At the 2nd roundabout, take the 2nd exit, straight over continuing on West Bay Road. Proceed down West Bay Road utilising the cruise traffic filter

lane. This will turn left on to Imperial Way. Head to the end of Imperial Way, turning left at the end, and the terminal will be directly on your right-hand side.

Mayflower Cruise Terminal, Berth 106, Herbert Walker Avenue, Southampton, SO15 OGN

By Plane

Southampton Airport is the closest regional airport to Mayflower Cruise Terminal. They have good onwards travel links to the Port of Southampton via rail links from Southampton Airport (Parkway) to Southampton Central Station, public bus and an on-site taxi rank. The drive time from Southampton Airport to Mayflower Cruise Terminal is approximately 25 minutes (5.3 miles) depending on traffic.

Other airports include Heathrow Airport (Approx. 1 hour 25 minutes' drive), Gatwick Airport (Approx. 1 hour 45 minutes' drive) and Bournemouth Airport (Approx. 45 minutes' drive). All have onward travel available to the Port of Southampton via rail, road, taxi and bus. Always allow extra time for traffic.
