TRAVELLING TO YOUR CRUISE TERMINAL ON EMBARKATION DAY

EASTERN DOCKS

QUEEN ELIZABETH II TERMINAL (BERTH 38/39)

By Foot

From Dock Gate 4 the walk is approximately 1 mile (20 minutes)
From Southampton Central Train Station the walk is approximately 2.5 miles (50 minutes)

By Train

The closest train station is *Southampton Central Station*. For easiest access to the cruise terminals, please exit via southern side of the railway station.

There is a taxi rank directly outside both the northern and southern side of the train station and can drop-off passengers directly outside of the cruise terminal.

QuayConnect offers a bus service running every 35 minutes from Southampton Central Station to Town Quay (Red Funnel Terminal stop). From Town Quay the walk is approximately 1.5 mile (30 minutes).

Alternatively, the walk from Southampton Central Train Station to Queen Elizabeth II Cruise Terminal is approximately 2.5 miles (45 minutes).

By Bus

No public buses stop directly outside of a cruise terminal, and onward travel is always necessary.

The three closest bus stations to Queen Elizabeth II Cruise Terminal is the Platform Tavern stop, Southampton NOCS stop and the Red Funnel Terminal stop (Town Quay).

The Platform Tavern stop serves bus routes 19, 19A, U1A, U1C and U1E and is approximately 1 mile (20 minutes) walk to the terminal.

The Southampton NOCS stop serves bus routes U1A and U1E and is approximately 0.7 miles (16 minutes) walk to the terminal.

The Red Funnel Terminal stop (Town Quay) serves the QuayConnect bus route and is approximately 1.5 mile (30 minutes) walk to the terminal.

By Coach (National Express)

T The closest coach station is Southampton Coach Station on Harbour Parade which is serviced by National Express.

You can take a pre-booked taxi from this location to the cruise terminal. Travel time is approximately 5 minutes, via Dock Gate 10, depending on traffic. There is a taxi rank at the coach station, alternatively there is a rank at Southampton Central Station which is approximately 0.3 miles away (6 minute walk).

Alternatively, the walk from Southampton Coach Station to Queen Elizabeth II Cruise Terminal is approximately 2.5 miles (50 minutes).

By Taxi

Private taxis can drop off directly outside of the cruise terminal. There is a taxi rank directly outside of each cruise terminal too.

By Car

For Queen Elizabeth II Cruise Terminal, entry into the port will be via Dock Gate 4. At the first roundabout, take the 2nd exit and proceed along Test Road for approximately 1 mile. The terminal is situated on the right-hand side.

By Plane

Southampton Airport is the closest regional airport to Queen Elizabeth II Cruise Terminal. They have good onwards travel links to the Port of Southampton via rail links from Southampton Airport (Parkway) to Southampton Central Station, public bus and an on-site taxi rank. The drive time from Southampton Airport to Queen Elizabeth II Terminal is approximately 20 minutes (5.2 miles) depending on traffic.

Other airports include Heathrow Airport (Approx. 1 hour 25 minutes' drive), Gatwick Airport (Approx. 1 hour 45 minutes' drive) and Bournemouth Airport (Approx. 45 minutes' drive). All have onward travel available to the Port of Southampton via rail, road, taxi and bus. Always allow extra time for traffic.
