Maintenance Dredging Operations Hythe Marine Park



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN maintenance dredging will commence today 19th March 2021 at Hythe Marine Park, near the Jetty and Pontoon during daylight hours until mid-April.

Vessels involved -

Dredger Boxer and Wootton & Two self-propelled split hopper barges, Split Two and Split Three maybe encountered between Hythe Marine Park and the Nab disposal area.

All vessels will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and mariners are advised to pass with caution.

The vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout dredging operations and mariners may also request movement information from Southampton VTS and Channel 12 if required.

This notice will be self-cancelling on completion of the dredging operations.
