

NOTICE TO MARINERS No 36 of 2022

Port of Southampton – Sanctions Against Russian Connected Vessels

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to Masters, Agents, Charterers and Ship Operators that the Department for Transport has issued sanctions against vessels including commercial, fishing and leisure vessels, that are owned, operated, managed, or connected with Russian companies.

With immediate effect, The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2022 (inclusive of all amendments and updates issued after this date) shall be fully complied with by ABP, 3rd party Terminal Operators and Marinas within the Southampton SHA area.

The Regulations prohibit Russian ships, and other ships specified by the Secretary of State, from entering ports in the United Kingdom. Agents are required to declare any vessels that fall under the definitions given by the Secretary of State, or that are suspected of being sanctioned vessels, to the Harbour Authority.
