

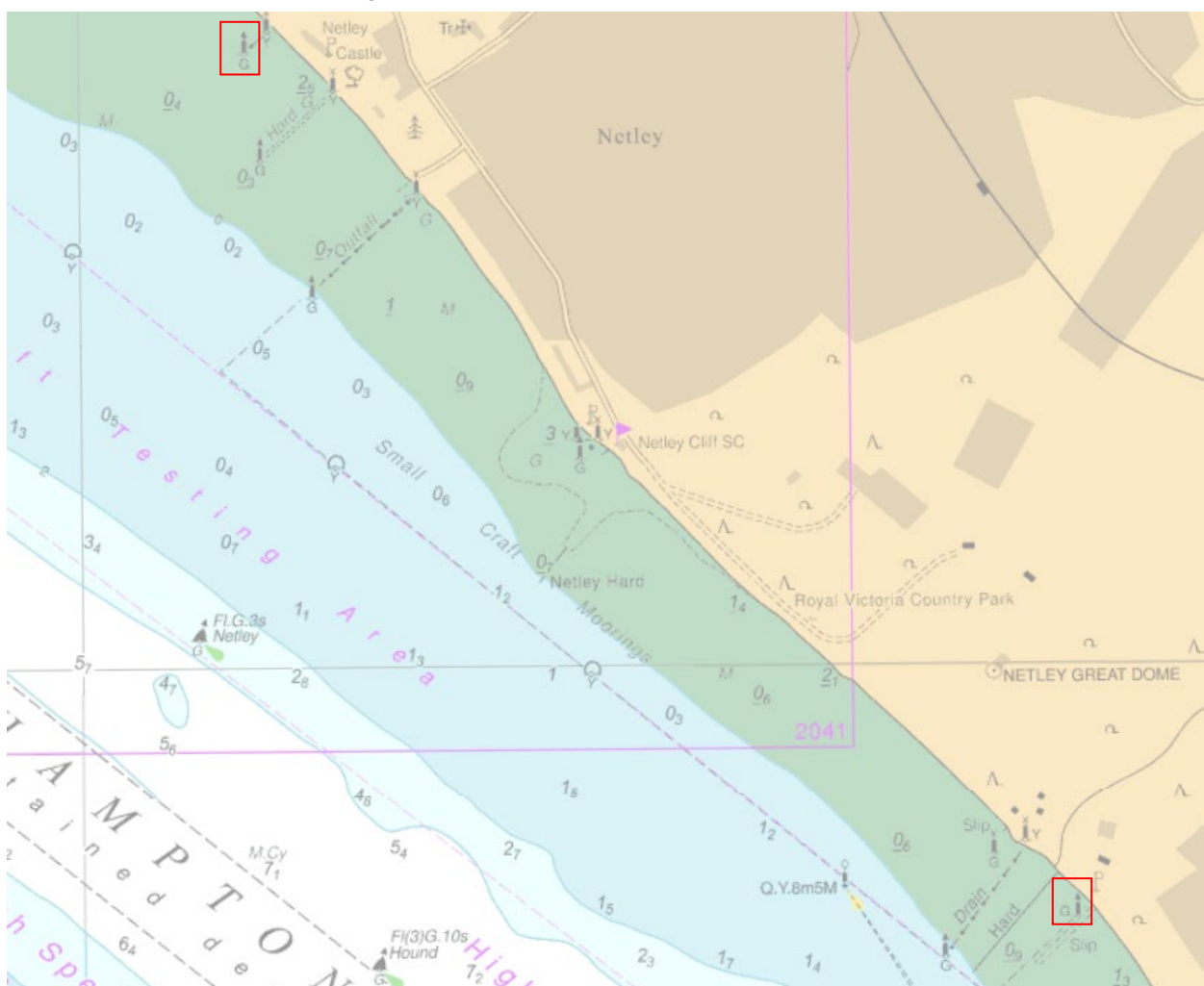
NOTICE TO MARINERS No 45 (T) of 2022 **Port of Southampton – Netley Outfall Beacons**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN- Two Outfall beacons have snapped and have been removed from service.

- 1- Netley Castle Outfall Beacon Seaward $001^{\circ} 21' 44.197''\text{W}$ $50^{\circ} 52' 39.00''\text{N}$
- 2- British Aerospace Outfall Beacon $001^{\circ} 20' 22.182''\text{W}$ $50^{\circ} 51' 44.028''\text{N}$

Vessels are requested to proceed with caution when navigating in the vicinity. Ahead of their passage, mariners may also request shipping information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.

This notice will be self-cancelling when the beacons have been returned to their charted positions
