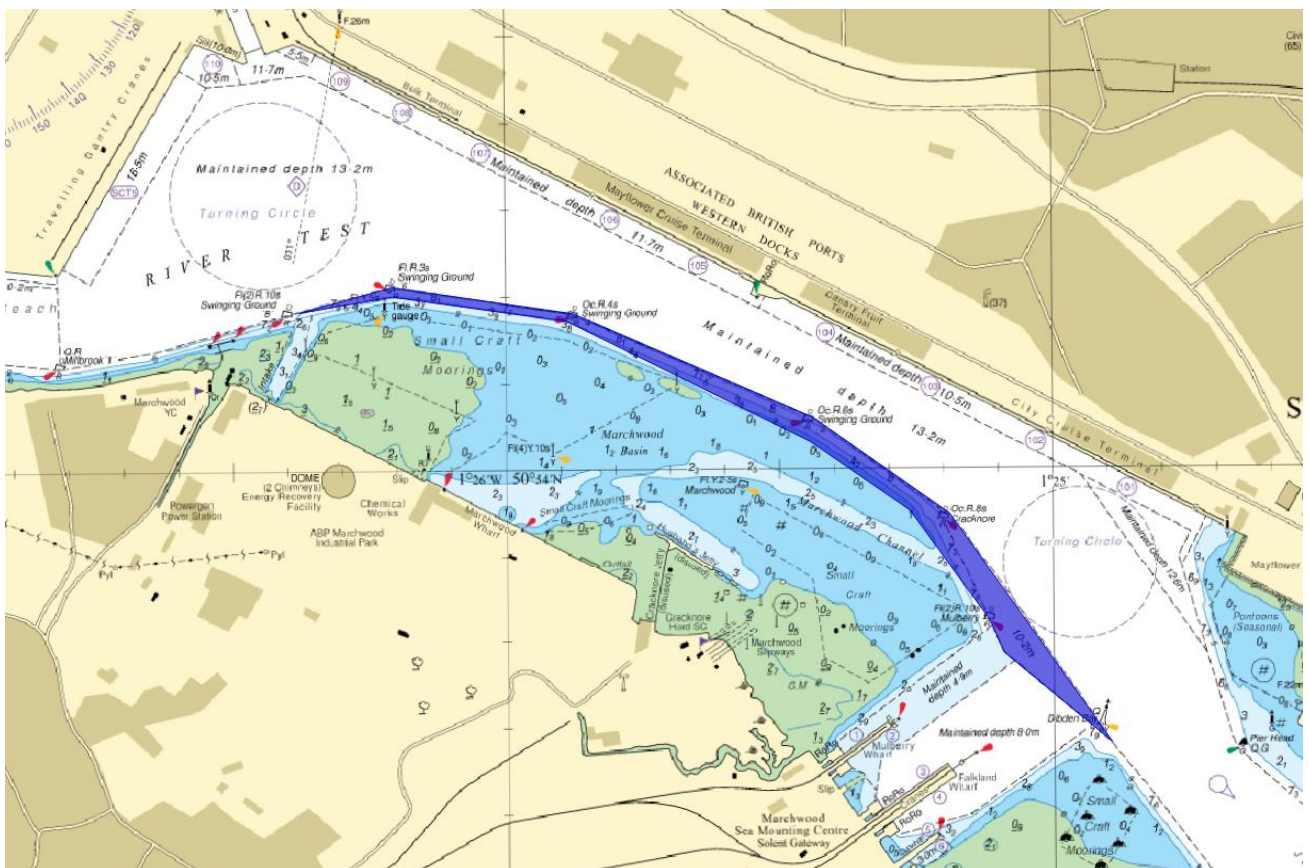


**NOTICE TO MARINERS No 23 (T) of 2024**  
**Port of Southampton**

**Western Docks Channel Widening Amendment 3.**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** - Dredging operations for widening the primary navigational channel in the Western Docks, between Swinging Ground No.8 and the Dibben Bay Cardinal, will take place between 1<sup>st</sup> January and 16<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Dredging operations will be continuous throughout the period.

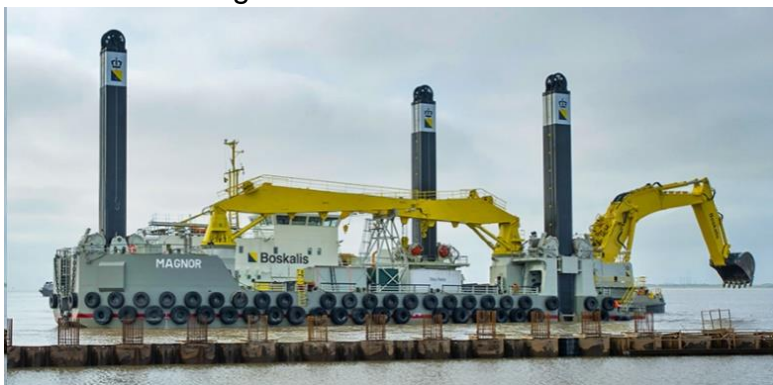


Works area highlighted in dark blue above.

The works will involve the vessels listed below:

### Vessels Involved

Backhoe Dredger **'MAGNOR'**



Trailer Suction Hopper Dredger **'CAUSEWAY'**



Tugs **'GPS AVENGER'**, **'UNION ONYX'** and **'UNION TOPAZ'**



Split Hopper Barges **'TERRAFARE 1'** and **'TERRAFARE 2'**

## Survey Vessels '**PORTHOS**' and '**ABP MERLIN**'



'**MAGNOR**' will load two non-propelled and one self-propelled Split Hopper Barge which will then be towed/pushed to the NAB TOWER disposal site by tugs.

'**GPS AVENGER**' maybe involved in bed levelling with her plough.

Mariners should expect to pass these vessels at any time between the upper reaches of the River Test, Southampton Water and the Nab disposal area.

All vessels will display the lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (ColRegs) and mariners are requested to reduce speed, as safe navigation permits, when passing a vessel which is engaged in dredging or loading activities.

All vessels involved will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout the operations. Mariners may request information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.
