

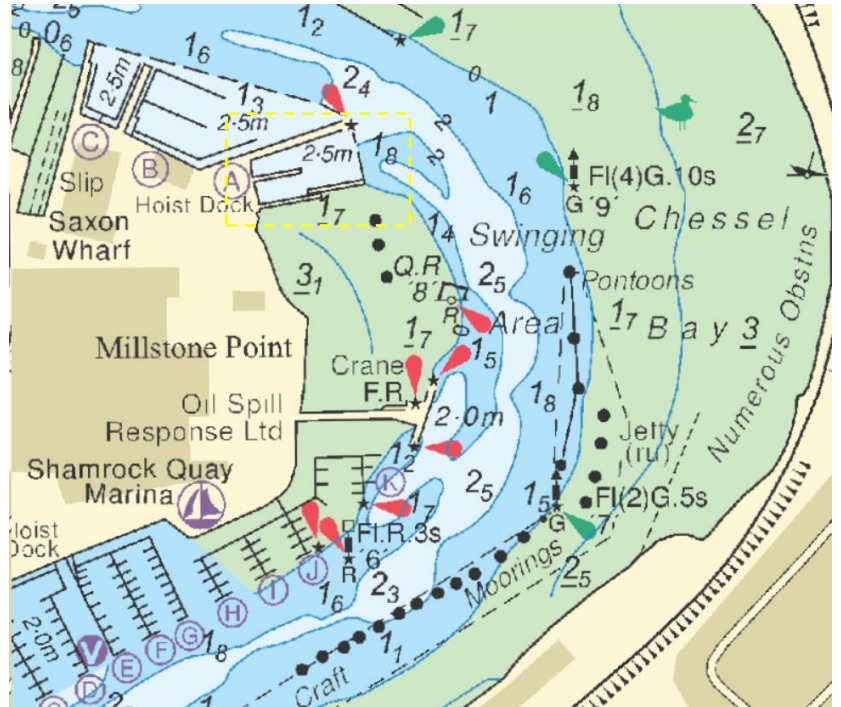
NOTICE TO MARINERS No 29 (T) of 2024 Port of Southampton

River Itchen

MDL Maintenance Dredging – January 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Jenkins Marine will be engaged in dredging operations in the River Itchen at Saxon Wharf from the 3rd – 12th January 2024 focusing on the area in front of the hoist dock.

Shamrock Quay dredging will commence on the 22nd of January 2024 for approximately 3 weeks, again focusing on the area in front of the hoist dock and upstream of pier J.

The dredgers and tender will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and mariners are requested to reduce speed as safe navigation permits when passing them whilst engaged in underwater activities.



Weather allowing, these operations will be continuous throughout the stated period and mariners should expect to pass at any time between the upper reaches of Southampton Water and the Nab or Hurst Disposal Ground.

The dredgers will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout dredging operations and mariners may also request movement information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.
