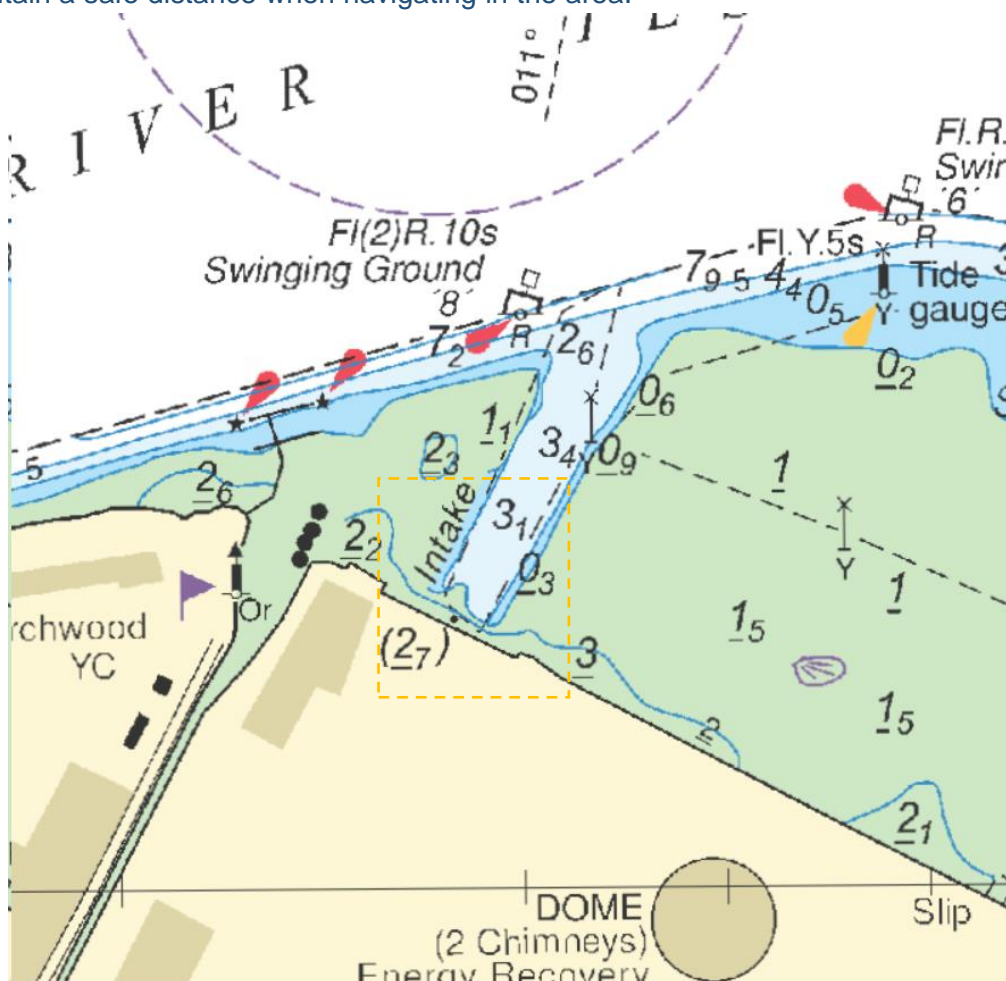


NOTICE TO MARINERS No 30 (T) of 2024
Port of Southampton

Marchwood ERF sea water intake dredging - Outside the navigational Channel of Southampton Water

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that ML Dredging will be engaged in dredging operations from the 4th January 2024 until the 29th February 2024 at the sea water intake of Marchwood ERF outside the navigational Channel of Southampton Water near port hand mark Swinging Ground No.8.

Works to be carried out outside of channel but a split hopper barge will be operating between the Dredge site (Marchwood ERF SW intake) and the Nab spoil ground once per day. Divers will be in the water periodically throughout the duration of the dredging so mariners should reduce wash and maintain a safe distance when navigating in the area.



The dredgers and tender will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and mariners are requested to reduce speed as safe navigation permits when passing them whilst engaged in underwater activities.

Weather allowing, these operations will be continuous throughout the stated period and mariners should expect to pass the split hopper barge at any time between the upper reaches of Southampton Water and the Nab Disposal Ground.

The dredgers will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout dredging operations and mariners may also request movement information from Southampton VTS on VHF Channel 12.
