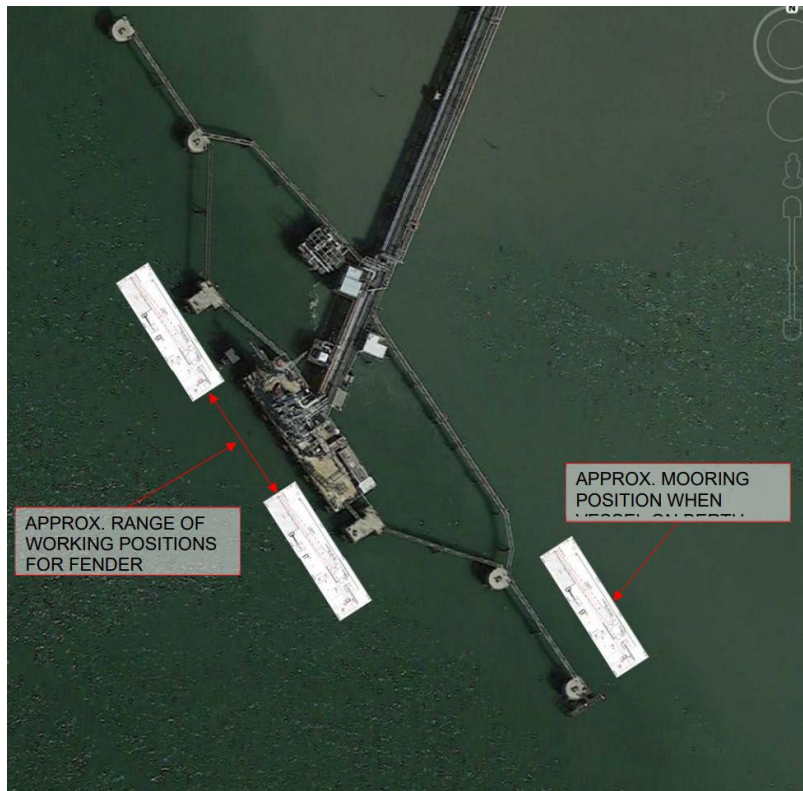
Port of Southampton – Spud leg barge working at BP Hamble Oil Jetty

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Spud leg barge ‘SPRUCELIGHT’ will be working with tug ‘Boojum Bay’ at BP Hamble Oil Jetty carrying out replacements and maintenance of jetty fenders. This will involve crane operations and diving works and it is estimated that the works will continue for 10 weeks. In the event of inclement weather the barge will seek shelter in the Port of Southampton.
